Treasurer	<ul> <li>Registration fees were down year over year due to slightly lower registration numbers</li> <li>Team billings were down due to lower estimates on number of home games and practices for rep teams; however we were able to sell some additional ice to teams which makes up the difference.</li> <li>Ice rental was below budget - had some ice cancelled to accommodate high school provincials at Shearwater</li> <li>We are expecting about \$1800 back from Hockey NS after the insurance true-up indicates we have overpaid.</li> <li>Bank charges are higher than planned driven by higher rates from GrayJayPay and SportsPay than NetBanx, our previous service provider, as well as the increased number of credit card transactions.</li> <li>League fees are higher than budget due to an unexpected \$235 charge from Metro Minor for U23. As well Hockey NS broke out their league fees from the insurance billing this year which would have previously showing up in the player and coach insurance invoice.
