Vice-President	Called to order 6:40pm. Nominations Adam - Nominates non-member Tanya Bezanson as an ESMHA executive member and appoint as U15 coordinator - Natalie seconded, all in favour. Tryout Jerseys Discussion on building tryout jerseys into base registration, roughly \$50 per mariner U11 and up. Tryout registration would decrease, and registration would increase - but every mariner would then have a jersey. Previous registration was ~\$765.00 U11 and up Discussion around ESMHA covering the \$50 per player for 2024 season, which would result in lowering the tryout cost Ice costs remaining the same as far as we know at this point Still have a set of U18 jerseys Providing jerseys would then open the BBQ to open the season for all players (U11 and up) to attend and pick up a jersey, not just those trying out Would cost approximately \$7500 Rod makes a motion to have ESMHA to cover the cost of tryout style jerseys for all players U11 and up, registration remains consistent. Coaching Coordination	 To be handled this season by committee Becky, Whitney, Adam & Rod volunteered to participate in the coaching coordinating/try out committee and sharing responsibility for this role Need to formulate a coaches application, post with registration and do the coaching selection process Review the coaching evaluations from previous seasons Discussed pre-season coaches meeting - with exec, managers, etc mandatory attendance - discussed shifting responsibility on those involved on the teams to ensure they have met the requirements in order to be on the ice 	
Try Outs	 With ice going in earlier, tryout process will be beginning earlier this season Discussed improvements to the process, pre-made on ice plans, alumni coaches for on ice sessions, organization (skills, tactical, scrimmage/games) ~\$110 cost per player (taking jersey's out of the costs) Discuss ice times guaranteed for tryouts and clearly communicate Create a package for parents - sample budget, expectations, ice time, commitment, etc. Can officially start on September 28th 	- Committee members to meet and discuss tryout process for this season
50/50	 Natalie will contact those who have funds but no grayjay account so she can apply the credit If they haven't done that, they can email her and she will add it Want everyone to pay via e-transfer, to avoid paying by credit card and getting a refund (as it costs the association) Anyone who has done a camp/try-out, they would already have an account Natalie will include the link for parents to use for grayjay 	
Grayjay	 Is Grayjay Pay - not the regular website Will be charging a \$5.00 fee as directed by Hockey Canada No longer creates a hockey Canada number automatically when you create an account - anyone who is brand new and has no Hockey Canada number, will fill out a form for Natalie and she will create a HCR account and provide them their number as registrations come through 	
Intro to Hockey	 Due to ice time restrictions for this season, will look different this season Potentially delivered as a block program (8-10 sessions) for the first half of the season before U9 games start Potentially re-visit in the winter when tournaments become popular for teams 	- Becky to communicate the information to previous intro participants
BBQ	 Market stays outside until end of September - Sunday, September 22nd Allows time to pass out try out jerseys after the BBQ and before tryouts 	
ED&I	 Will share information on an indigenous player program at RBC for interested players Parents can self-identify on their registration forms and we can forward relevant information to those families for any programs available New code of conduct policy from HNS expectations on behaviours for everyone in the rink
