# **ALL Registration Opens July 7th**

### Registration Closing Dates (to ease confusion)

- U13AAA Closes Sept 1 at 12:01AM
- U11 U18 Competitive Closes Sept 7 at 12:01AM
- U7, U9 and U11 U18 Recreation Closes Sept 22 at 12:01AM
- <u>U13AAA Registration</u> all steps below <u>MUST</u> be followed to tryout for U13AAA. There are no exceptions.

<u>Please note</u> – if you do not register within the listed timelines, there is no guarantee that your registration will be accepted. You will be placed on a waiting list and will only be contacted if there is space on teams that have been formed.

<u>U18 Tier 2:</u> this is a new initiative this season to gage if there is interest at the U18 C level to have 1 practice in addition to games. If there is not enough interest, these players will be shifted back to U18C and refunded accordingly.

<u>U23</u> – We are hoping to have enough players to ice a team. If not, registered players will be refunded.

<u>Checking Clinics:</u> Players who are new to U15 (A or AA) or U18 (A or AA) Competitive hockey and interested in playing checking hockey <u>must complete</u> an approved checking clinic prior to tryouts in September.

<u>U15 Major, U18 Major, High School:</u> Players trying out for U15 Major, U18 Major, or High School are <u>encouraged to register</u> with their home hockey association. Payment not required. If you are successful in making one of these teams, please contact <u>admin@halifaxhawks.ca</u> to have your registration removed; if unsuccessful, payment is required to proceed to Hawks tryouts or Recreation hockey.

# FEES & PAYMENT PLANS (see chart below)

#### **Payment options:**

- 1. Pay in full by email transfer to <a href="mailto:admin@halifaxhawks.ca">admin@halifaxhawks.ca</a> (preferred) or credit card through HCR
- 2. Choose payment plan on HCR which includes 3 payments (first payment on day registered, with second and third payments due a month, then 2 months later. For example, if you register on July 4, the first payment is due that day then August 4 and September 4). Payments can be email transfers to <a href="mailto:admin@halifaxhawks.ca">admin@halifaxhawks.ca</a> or credit card. You will receive reminder emails from Spordle for your next etransfer payment but ultimately it is up to you to keep up to date with this.
  - 50:50 and other credits have been added to the HCR 3.0, please pay the net registration total.
  - If you register for Competitive hockey, tryout fees are automatically added to your total fees.

If selected to a competitive team, there are additional costs above these fees. These can range from \$500-\$2,000 or in very rare cases, more. Teams will fundraise to help offset some of these costs, but parents should take this expense into consideration when registering for competitive try outs. Players who make a competitive team are required to pay a competitive fee to cover added costs for ice time, officials, and league fees; additionally, a sock fee may be required for standard issued home and away hockey socks. Competitive and sock fees are paid by players directly to their team by November.

### **Fundraising and Team Specific Fee Commitment**

There will be additional team fees during the season that are required for the effective funning of Halifax Hawks teams (competitive and recreation). Players may be asked to participate in team-specific fundraising initiatives or otherwise, will be required to pay the difference if they choose not to participate. These fees will be used for such things are extra ice purchases, registration fees for tournaments, etc. You are encouraged to make these fees part of the financial forecast for the season, prior to registering.

# **REFUNDS**

All requests for refunds must be made in writing to <u>admin@halifaxhawks.ca</u>. We ask that you remain patient during the busy time of registration for a response.

- Refunds will be assessed on a case-by-case basis
  - Refunds will not be granted for injuries
- Approved refunds may have a \$35 administration applied plus insurance and Hockey Canada Fees
- If you participated in tryouts but are not successful in making a competitive team, tryout fees are not refunded. The tryout fee includes extra ice for tryouts.
- **Prior to Sept 15:** Refunds for Competitive hockey will be considered.
- Prior to October 15: Refunds for Recreational hockey will be considered.

## **FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE**

We understand that hockey is expensive, and we want to give every player who wants to play the game the chance to do so. There are several programs that can assist with the cost. Some have limited funding so apply early.
