Suggested ideas to discuss:

- Introduction of coaches & parents
- Overview of coaches' philosophy & plan for the season
- Coaches' rules & expectations; Hawks Pledges (see slide on Hawks pledges)
- Team Budget (approved by divisional director, presented to families to be voted on
 - It is a good idea to send a mid- year update to parents/guardians to report progress against the original team budget and advise families of their contributions and any projected short fall or surplus
- Extra Ice Fees/ Sock Fees/Competitive Fees – some teams will be higher than others
- Charitable event for community events/opportunities
- Fundraising Opportunities
- Tournaments – discuss when, where, the cost etc (click tournament link in our list)
- Have parents fill out and return a player medical form (insert link)
