

TEAM FEES – Competitive vs Recreation

- <u>Team Fees</u> If selected to a competitive team, there are additional costs above these fees. These can range from \$500- \$2,000 or in very rare cases more. Teams will fundraise to help offset some of these costs, but parents should take this expense into consideration when registering for competitive try outs.
- Competitive Fees Players who make a competitive team are required to pay a competitive fee to cover added costs for ice time, officials, and league fees; additionally, a sock fee may be required for standard issued home and away hockey socks. Competitive and sock fees are paid by players to their team in November
- Recreation Teams Recreation teams may also decide at their parents meeting to collect fees for extra ice, tournament fees etc.
- There is a waiver during the registration process that families have had to agree to pay both team fees and competitive fees.
