Ages 9 & 10

Goalies at this age should show relative consistency with goaltending core skills. Most all goalies will be adjusting to regulation size nets, and therefore still need time to fully learn depth, angles, and depth management. Goalies also start to show signs of in game reads and situation play/awareness.

Heavily Weighted Areas of Evaluation:

Skating: Edges, T-Pushes, Shuffles, C-Cuts

Technical: Stance, Balance, Hands, Butterfly, Puck Tracking

Tactical: Depth, Angles, Butterfly Usage, Patience On Their Feet

Mental: Compete, Battle, Willingness to learn, Handling Adversity

Lightly Weighted Areas of Evaluation:

Tactical: Shot Location(High or Low & Proper Response), Lateral Power, Rebound Control

Mental: Situation Reads, In-Zone Awareness, Head Checks, understanding Positioning
