7) Jerseys/Name Bars/Socks:

- a. Deposit of \$50/jersey (will be refunded upon return at end of season)

8) **24-hour Policy**:

Parent Responsibilities:

- ❖ If you have any questions/concerns regarding hockey practices/games, etc. please bring up with the team manager who will discuss with coaches.
- ❖ Families will be required to sell SRMHA 50/50 tickets at rates indicted by the SRMHA 50/50 Coordinator.
- Update availability on Grayjay asap
- Check schedule on GrayJay regularly (it can change)
- Use GrayJay messages-chat to communicate when we are not at practices/games
- Parents are not permitted in the dressing rooms before/after practices and games.
- Always wait 24 hours before speaking to anyone regarding incidents
- Do not post videos to social media.
- ❖ Always have permission from parents before posting pictures of their children
- * **Reminder Jerseys need to be passed in at the end of the season and must be in similar condition to receive your refund**

DRESSING ROOM SUPERVISION Hockey Nova Scotia requires all Coaches/Bench staff and member Minor Hockey Associations to provide supervision for dressing rooms before, during and after all games and practices by following the "Rule of Two formally known as the Two Deep Method" of supervision recommended by Hockey Canada (No parents in the dressing room). A lone personnel member should never be in the dressing room with players at any time, especially when players are showering or changing: two adults should be present together, this is called the "Rule of Two formally known as the Two Deep Method" of supervision. Parents of all players should be made aware of the "Rule of Two formally known as the Two Deep Method" and avoid letting their children into unsupervised dressing rooms. (The regulation requires that no player is left unattended, and no adult is left alone supervising players. So, unless it is a parent and their child, there needs to be two adult dressing room monitors at all times.) As Manager, you need to ensure that this policy is always followed and may be required to assist with ensuring the rule is followed.
